

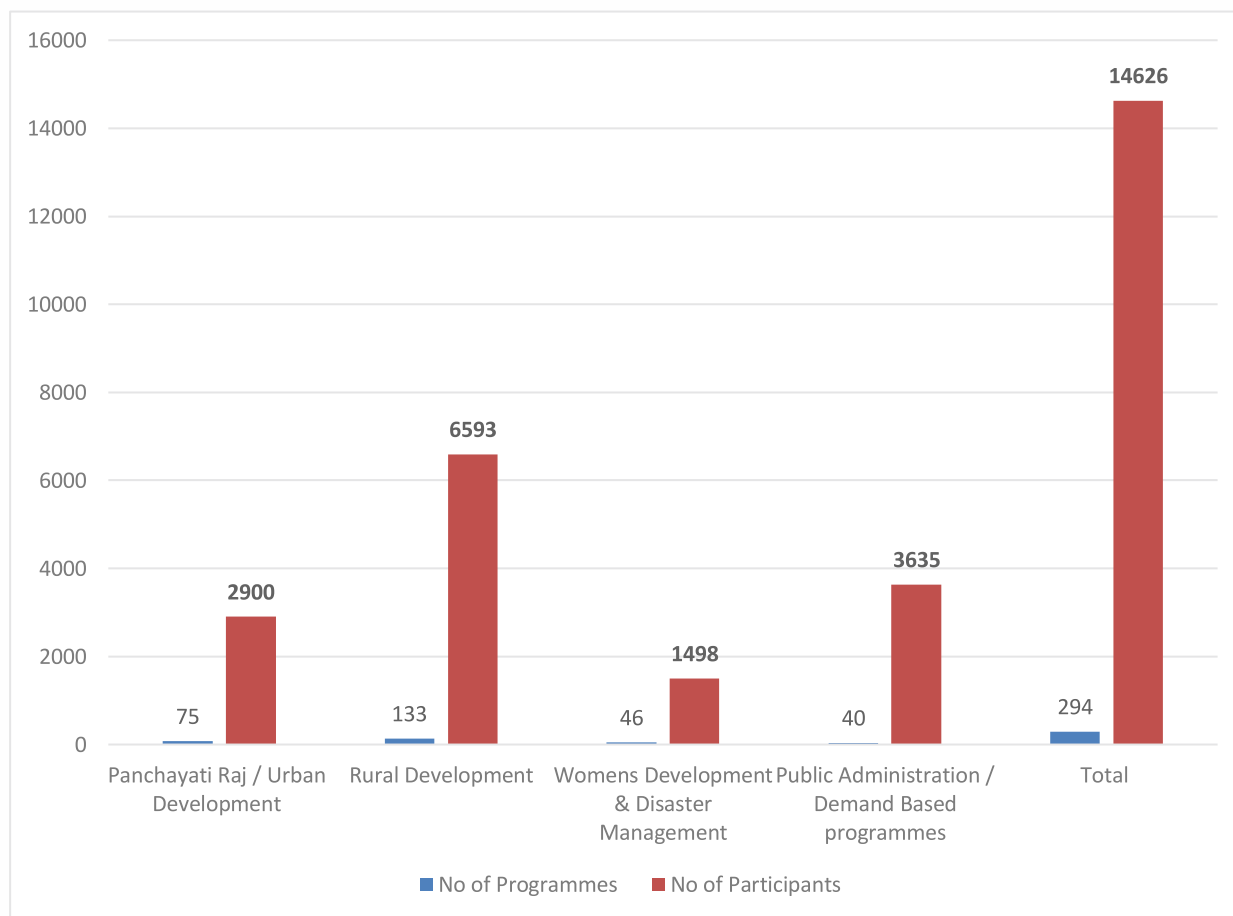

## 5. Activities and Events conducted during the year 2021 - 22

### COVID-19 : IEC Material and dissemination

1. **Local Self Bodies and their role in the management of COVID-19:** a 4-page illustrated flyer, which serves as a ready reckoner for the Local Bodies to initiate need based measures at local level to fight the effects of the ongoing pandemic.

2. **Post COVID ... Do's and Dont's:** a 2-page flyer, which covers the essential measures one must take in cases of persons who have been infected by the disease, as also certain guidelines for the care givers and community members. This flyer was prepared by Director GIPARD & Core Faculty in women's development in consultation with *Dr. Anika Parrikar, Consultant in Chest Medicine at Healthway Hospitals* and the *Department of Preventive and Social Medicine, Goa Medical College and Hospital*.

3. **Do's and Dont's for Home Isolation:** a 2-page flyer, which covers in details the precautionary measures for the COVID-19 patients in home isolation, their caregivers, including community members. This flyer was prepared by core faculty in women's development in consultation with the *Department of Preventive and Social Medicine, Goa Medical College and Hospital*.

4. **Role of SHG's in Management of the COVID-19 pandemic at Community Level:** a 4-page illustrated flyer prepared by the Core Faculty in Rural Development (RD) at GIPARD and this has been circulated as an essential tool for the SHG network in the State.

5. **Rural SHG Women: The Secret Angel during COVID times:** Under the *Streeshakti* programme of the *Goa State Level Rural Livelihood Mission*; the Core Faculty in RD at GIPARD has documented the efforts of ten Women Block / Community Resource Persons

who through their network of SHG's have reached out to thousands of needy during the difficult days of the pandemic and resultant lockdown.



6. **GIPARD has printed Table Top Calendars and Monthly Planners for the year 2022** for distribution amongst Village Panchayats / Municipalities / Zilla Panchayat (Local Body) Members, Self Help Groups Functionaries, Resource Persons, Heads of Departments, etc.

These Table Top Calendars and Monthly Planners were released on 03 / 01 / 2022, at the hands of **Dr. Pramod Sawant**, Hon'ble Chief Minister, Government of Goa, in the distinguished presence of **Sh. Vishwajeet Rane**, Hon'ble Minister for Health, **Sh. Parimal Rai**, IAS, Chief Secretary & Chairman, GIPARD and **Sh. Michael M. D'Souza**, IAS, Director (Training), GIPARD.



### **I. Memorandum of Understanding with Educational Institutions:**

**GIPARD has signed MoU with 25 Institutions of Higher Education on 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2022**, in the presence of **Sh. Ravi Dhawan, IAS, Secretary, Higher Education, & Sh. Prasad Lolayekar, IAS, Director (Higher Education)**. The objective of the MoU is to collaborate with these Institutes of Higher Education for the conduct of Training Programmes and Research Activities.



**II. Lecture Series:** GIPARD in collaboration with Department of Political Science, Goa University, organized a lecture on '**Challenges to Public Administration in India**'. The session was held online for officers, faculty and students of Goa University. **Professor (Dr.) Sreenivas G. Reddy**, from Kakatiya University delivered the session. **45 participants** attended the lecture.

#### **Report on the Financial Statements**

We have audited the accompanying financial statements of Goa Institute of Public Administration and Rural Development.(GIPARD) Which comprise the Balance Sheet as at 31 March 2022, the Statement of Income & Expenditure account and Receipt and payment account for the year then ended, and a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information.

#### **Management's Responsibility for the Financial Statements**

The Management of GIPARD is responsible for the matters in with respect to the preparation of these financial statements that give a true and fair view of the financial position, financial performance of GIPARD. In accordance with the accounting principles generally accepted in India. This responsibility also includes the maintenance of adequate accounting records for safeguarding of the assets of the GIPARD and for preventing and detecting the frauds and other irregularities; selection and application of appropriate accounting policies; making judgments and estimates that are reasonable and prudent; and design, implementation and maintenance of internal financial control, that were operating effectively for ensuring the accuracy and completeness of the accounting records, relevant to the preparation and presentation of the financial statements that give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

#### **Auditor's Responsibility**

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit. We have taken into account the provisions of the Act, the accounting and auditing standards and matters which are required to be included in the audit report under the provisions of Society Regulation Act 1980(Central Act XXI of 1860) and the Rules made there under.

We conducted our audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing which require that we comply with ethical requirements and plan and perform the audit

to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free from material mis-statement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the financial statements, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal financial control relevant to GIPARD's preparation of the financial statements that give true and fair view in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of the accounting estimates made by Managements of GIPARD, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial statements.

### **Report on other Legal and Regulatory Requirements**

We report that:

- a) There are substantial grants which are received for some specified activities have remained unutilised for more than a year, and Such grants are apportioned towards Staff welfare and repairs & maintenance corpus during the financial year. Approval from concerned department has not been obtained.
- b) Administrative expenses of the GIPARD are not utilised from Administrative funds/Reserve ( As per GIPARD rules 20% of grants expenditure to recovered as Administrative Fund/reserve. Such fund to be utilised for administrative purpose and other purposes.)
- c) There was reportedly zero Meeting of executive committee during the financial year ended 31.03.2022. the number of meetings were not as per the provisions of GIPARD Rules which require at least one Meeting in every three

months. There was only one meeting of board of Governors during the financial year ending 31.03.2022

In arriving our opinion, we reported that

- a) We have sought and obtained all the information and explanation which to the best of our knowledge and belief were necessary for the purpose of our audit.
- b) In the opinion, proper books of account are required by law have been kept by the society so far as it appears from our examination of the books of account
- c) The balance sheet and statement of Income and expenditure and Receipt and Payment account dealt with by the report are in agreement with the books of account.
- d) In our opinion, the aforesaid financials comply with the applicable accounting standards.

**Report on other Legal and Regulatory Requirements of the Statutory Audit of GIPARD for the year 2021-2022.**

In response to the observations made by the Statutory Auditor in the Audit Report relating to the functions and accounts of GIPARD, the Institute submits the following response / clarification:

a) **Observation 1:** There are some grants which were received for some specified activities from various departments of the State and Central Government over the years which have remained unutilised during the year. Such grants have been apportioned towards Staff Welfare and Repairs & Maintenance Corpus during the financial year. Approval from Board of Governors or the Department(s) has not been obtained.


**Response:** The grants released to GIPARD are of the past many years (more than 07 years). Moreover, the scheme which were operational then, have been closed by the Ministry / Departments concerned. Hence the funds are transferred to Staff Welfare and Repairs & Maintenance Corpus. However, if the Ministry / Departments require the Institute to surrender these funds the same will be return to the Ministry / Departments concerned.

b) **Observation 2:** Administrative expenses of GIPARD which are charged for each programme are not utilised from administrative funds / Reserve, instead shown as grant expenditure. (As per GIPARD rules 20% of grants expenditure is recovered as Administrative Fund / Reserve. Such fund to be utilised for administrative purpose and other purpose)

**Response:** The utilisation of above funds will be done for the Staff Welfare and administrative purpose of the GIPARD with effect from April, 2022, as per the SoP defined for the purpose and approved by the Board of Governors.

c) **Observation 3:** There was reportedly no Meetings of Executive Committee during the financial year ended 31.03.2022. The number of meetings were not as per the provisions of GIPARD Rules which require at least one meeting in every three months. There was only one Meeting of Board of Governors during the financial year ending 31.03.2022.

**Response:** The meetings of the Executive Committee could not be convened during the year on account of several COVID-19 related restrictions, as also, substantial tasks were completed with the prior approval of the Board of Governors, and with administrative approvals of the functionaries of the Board and the Department of Personnel (for programme approval) / Finance (for budgetary allocation and releases), who incidentally are members of the Executive Committee. Further, the need of having four meetings is not felt necessary on account of the Government approving a very detailed Comprehensive Revised Pattern of Assistance detailing the mode of utilisation of funds and conduct of activity etc.
