Structure and function of the Department

Director General of Police is the Head of the Goa Police Department. The Police Headquarters is located in the Capital city of Panaji. For effective policing, the State jurisdiction is divided into two Districts i.e North & South and each District is headed by an officer of the rank of Superintendent of Police. The Districts are further Sub-divided into 8 Sub Divisions, 4 in North Goa and 4 in South Goa District. Each Sub Division is headed by an officer of the rank of Dy. Supdt. of Police. The North District Police with its Headquarters at Porvorim covers the Sub Divisions of Panaji, Mapusa, Porvorim and Bicholim and the South District Police with its Headquarters at Margao covers areas of Margao, Vasco, Quepem and Ponda Sub Divisions. There are 31 Police Stations in Goa, of which 13 are in North and 18 in South District. Besides, there are 07 Coastal Security Police Stations i.e Siolim, Tiracol, Chapora, Panaji Coastal Police Stations in North and Harbour, Betul & Talpona Coastal Police Stations in South District. These Police Stations are headed by an officer of the rank of Police Inspector under overall supervision of Superintendent of Police (Coastal). Likewise there is one Konkan Railway Police Station at Margao headed by one Police Inspector under overall supervision of Superintendent of Police (Konkan Railway). There are 44 Police Out Posts, of which 20 are in North and 24 in South District. These Out Posts are headed by an officer of the rank of Assistant Sub Inspector.

The total strength of Goa Police Department is 8912. This includes ministerial staff, other Technical staff and 1st, 2nd & 3rd IRBn (**Annexure-I**). In all 97% of the offices/Establishments are functioning in the buildings owned by the Goa Police Department.

The details of Budget for Demand No. 17 under various major and minor Heads are indicated in enclosed (**Annexure II**).

NEW ADDITIONS

1. **Repairs and Maintenance Projects:** - Various Police buildings including residential Quarters have been repaired/renovated. An amount of Rs.486.97 lakhs has been spent on maintenance of Police buildings.
2. **Construction of Major Buildings:** - The project "Construction of building for Police Station at Quepem is underway and 70% works are completed. Similarly, the revised estimates amounting to Rs.15.63 crores and Rs.9.49 crores respectively towards construction of Maina Curtorim Police Station & 30 'B' type Quarters at Arlem, Fatorda were forwarded to Home Department for according Administrative Approval and Expenditure Sanction. So also, the project viz. construction of Sanguem Police Station, Fatorda Police Station, 'F' type bungalow at Porvorim and new building for Police Headquarters are in pipeline.

CRIME SITUATION

The overall crime situation in the state remained under control. The Goa Police registered 2380 cases under IPC and detected 2002 during the period from 01.04.2022 to 31.03.2023. The Law and order situation remained well under control and all National and International events passed off peacefully due to implementation of various preventative measures and better staffing.

ANTI NARCOTIC CELL/POLICE STATION

Anti Narcotic Cell Police Station, Panaji Goa continued its efforts to tackle the drug menace in the state. The constant and untiring efforts of Anti Narcotic Cell Police Station to apprehend the dealers in the drug prone areas has resulted in considerable curbing of drug menace in the state of Goa.

During the year 2022-23, Anti Narcotic Cell has booked 29 cases and seized 51 kgs. 693 grams and 19 mgrams of various types of drugs worth Rs.2,14,63,800/-

To create a strong deterrent impact against the drug trafficking activities, in the drug-prone areas of Goa like Calangute, Baga, Anjuna, Vagator, Chapora, Arambol, Colva, Palolim, Mazorda etc. are kept under continuous surveillance. Additional force of One Battalion IRBN have been patrolling in these areas.

CRIMINAL INVESTIGATION DEPARTMENT

The crime control, safety and security of life and property in the State, maintaining of peace and tranquility, communal harmony, prevention and detection of crime and law and order in the State.

TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT

During the year 2022-23 beside regulation and enforcement of Traffic Laws, reduction in accidents has remained top priority of Traffic Police. Traffic Police worked against various odds, such as bad road condition, inadequately trained drivers/riders, indiscipline road traffic etc. to achieve this goal. Goa Police (Traffic) have booked **4,34,593** traffic violators. As a part of **educational drive** during the year 2022-23 total **59,102 Students** and **93,789 drivers** were given lectures on road safety.

SENIOR CITIZEN HELPLINE

Goa Police also launched dedicated **helpline for Senior Citizen with toll free landline No. 1090** for promptly attending calls and complaints from Senior Citizen to extend them help and provide required assistance. The objective of the helpline is to ensure safety and security of Senior Citizens.

ANTI CORRUPTION MEASURES

It is noteworthy to make a mention that Goa Police in its endeavor to weed out corruption/extortion in its ranks and files have launched special email ID **goapolice.vigilance@nic.in** and a dedicated mobile number **7030100000** to receive complaints and redress such grievances/complaints.

WOMEN POLICE CELL/POLICE STATION

In order to prevent crime against women, a special cell for women was established vide Government Notification No.1/11/93-CM/55/292 dated 24-09-1993. This cell was declared as Women Police Station vide Government order dated 17-08-2000 and started functioning in newly renovated premises at Police Headquarters, Panaji. This woman Police Station is having jurisdiction for the entire State of Goa.

The women Police Station deals with cases pertaining to Rape, Kidnapping and abduction, dowry death, molestation, sexual harassment, offences under immoral traffic (Prevention) Act 1956. Indecent representation of women (Prohibition) Act 1986 and the Dowry Prohibition Act 1961.

WOMEN HELPLINE

Goa Police has launched dedicated **Women helpline for women with toll free landline No. 1091** is operating round the clock to attend the calls/complaints of the women. Women help Desk has also been opened at all Police Station. The WhatsApp Number is 7875756177.

IMPORTANT ACHIEVEMENT /PROJECTS COMPLETED/PARTLY COMPLETED DURING 2022-23.

COASTAL SCHEME

There are 07 Coastal Security Police Stations. The construction of building for Coastal Security Police Station at Chapora and Annex building to existing Coastal Security Police Station at Tiracol, Pernem are undergoing and likely to be completed shortly. Similarly, the project viz. "Construction of building for Coastal Security Police Station Talpona" has accorded Administrative Approval of the Government and conveyed to PWD to take up e-tendering process.

MODERNIZATION

The project estimated cost of Rs.101.29 crores "Construction of new building for Police Out Post Betim" has been completed and inaugurated on 09.11.2022. Whereas, the project "Construction of building for Police Station at Quepem" (estimated cost of Rs. 7.73 crores) is underway.

INITIATIVES

Following initiatives have been taken by the Police Department:-

1. Samadhan:- The Police Department has initiated a grievance redressal scheme styled as samadhan to ensure speedy redressal of public grievances.
2. Cyber Awareness:- A number of programmes have been organized in Schools, Colleges to create awareness about Cyber Crime.
3. A manual on 'Special Branch' has been prepared.
4. Operation Jagruti to ensure safety and security to the women was operated at all Police Stations. Besides, intensive Police patrolling through Pink Force and officer was maintained throughout the night.
5. Goa Police launched "Cretathon" event for student of Goa Engineering College, Farmagudi, Ponda, in view of MoU signed between Goa Police

and Goa Engineering College with a aimed for creating E-Beat book system.

6. Regular meetings are hold with PIs and SDPOs with different stakeholders to brief about the preventive measures to be taken up with regards to the safety of Tourist and other.
7. Regular interaction is done with members of community through Community Meetings at the Police Station and Sub Division levels to connect the Police Officers with public on a personal level to identify and address the root causes of crime and other community issues.
8. The regular visits are made to the houses of the senior citizens staying alone to provide necessary assistance to make them feel safe and secure.
9. The periodic “Cultural Events” are organized at the Police Station level to ensure fair and respectful interactions with all community members.
10. Operation Kavach was implemented by Goa Police to maintained Law & Order in the State.
11. “Prayas” is an initiative under taken by the Police Department with objectives to create awareness among people living in slums and low income groups to keep the youths living in slums area away from entering into crime and safeguarding women and children.
12. “Know your Neighbours” Special Tenant/Servant/Foreigners verification drive was initiated to get Tenant/Servant forms filled and verified.
13. “Walk the Beat” is performed by PIs alongwith staff of Police Stations, wherein roll calls, flag march, foot patrolling, briefing in Beat area of every Police Station, which helps to collect intelligence, inputs to build good relation with General Public.
14. Anti-Terrorism Squad of Goa Police is gearing up by specializing in special combat training, introducing of new technology and weapon tactics, acquiring better armor and getting prepared to tackle any type of terror activities in the State of Goa.
15. Anti-Terrorism Squad of Goa Police has prepared an action plan to counter terror situation and for this purpose a Standard Operating Procedure (SOP's) also prepared to tackle terror related incidents defining role of each agency and stakeholders during emergencies.
16. The Joint Counter Terrorist exercise are held yearly in Goa with the Special Action Group, NSG and Mumbai/Manesar.
17. Intelligence wing of ATS conducts door to door random checking of tenants/migrants/servants staying in the State of Goa, who skip the process of verification done by local Police.
18. Anti-Terrorism Squad Quick Reaction Team patrolling has been strengthened and intelligence wing has been alerted to develop sources and collect intelligence from terror point of view, to prevent any act of unlawful interference/untoward incident in the State of Goa.
