(b)	Whether the Government is aware about the Health impact assessment conducted by Primary Health Centre at Balli, if so, steps taken to address the Health issues of people of respective areas facing due to pollution caused by Cuncolim Industrial Estate;	The Primary Health Centre, Balli field staff (ANMs & MPHWs) has done a survey in the areas adjoining to Cuncolim Industrial Estate. This survey was based on an oral questionnaire with the people found at their residences at the time of their visit. Survey was conducted in Simplear, Kegdicotto, Masconi, Bellathemb, Gullecotto, Bhatti, Takaband and IDC. The following complaints/health issues were conveyed by the people of these areas. Total of 449 houses were visited by the team. 1. Simplear Respiratory problem-05 persons. Skin allergy-03 persons. Asthma-02 persons.
