## **ANSWER**

Will the Minister for Agriculture be pleased to state:

- a) Whether it is a fact that orchid farmers in the State do not receive any specific support or assistance from the Government:
- No Sir. The Agriculture Department has provided support to orchid farmers for such infrastructure as construction Polyhouse. 50% support under Mission for Integrated Development of Horticulture (MIDH) -National Horticulture Mission and 50% support under State Sector Scheme "Assistance for Protected Cultivation for growing flowers and vegetables" and 50% support for planting material under Mission for Integrated Development of Horticulture-
- b) if so, the reasons therefor and whether the Government has any plans to introduce schemes or incentives specifically for orchid farmers:
- b) The State Government is implementing the "Assistance Sector Scheme Revitalization of Polyhouses under Protected Cultivation." Further, a proposal for a new scheme specifically to support polyhouse cultivation of orchids and anthuriums is under consideration.

- c) The total number of farmers engaged in orchid cultivation across Goa with district-wise or taluka-wise details with their names, addresses and contact numbers; and
- c) The District-wise/Taluka-wise total number of farmers engaged in Orchid cultivation across Goa along with names, addresses and contact numbers are givent Annexure.

- d) Whether any existing agricultural schemes are applicable to orchid farmers; if so, the details of such schemes along with the number of orchid farmers that have availed benefits under such schemes?
- d) Yes. The existing agricultural schemes applicable to orchid growers/farmers are as follows:
  - Assistance for Setting up of Structure –
    Naturally Ventilated System:
    Tubular/Rectangular Structure:
  - \* Rs.1200/sq.m (up to 500 sq.m)
  - \* Rs.1050/sq.m (500 to 1008 sq.m)
  - \* Rs.1000/sq.m (above 1008 to 2500 sq.m) 50% assistance is provided, with a maximum area limit of 2500 sq.m per beneficiary.
  - 2. Assistance for Planting Material: 50% assistance of Rs.700/sq.m is provided, limited to a maximum of 2500 sq.m per beneficiary.
